Why should I attend a NEI 12-Step Retreat?

I am Rita from the North country, Canada, and live in a bilingual city, Montreal, where English is the minority. There was only one small English speaking "S" fellowship in January 2000 but I found out there were other 12-Step "S" programs with more literature, more inclusivity and nearby with 12-Step Retreats of S.L.A.A. I knew I had to go to surround myself with sober people and maybe find a sponsor.

So I registered and brought 3 other members with me to my first NEI Chester Vermont 12-Step Retreat in December 2002. I even found a sponsor!

You might ask, "Why in heaven's name would I attend one or more NEI 12-Step retreats annually for all these years?" Good question. My answer is, "Insurance." My experience is that the holidays can be a very triggering time for me. My insurance is to attend the December Vermont 12-Step retreat.

Besides, there is nothing like a picturesque quaint little New England village like Chester VT to work the Steps and reconnect with my higher power. I enjoy taking long walks in the early mornings and re-discover that farm girl in me; and as a bonus, see my long-distance sponsor in person.

In January 2015 I discovered that I was a sexual anorexic (when I think about it, isn't sexual acting out also sexual anorexia?). Then NEI had its first Anorexia 12-Step Retreat in September 2015, I had to go. Would you believe there is another one September 23-25, 2016? I am going... I hope you are too.
