S.L.A.A. celebrates 40 years December 30, 1976!

The first meeting of S.L.A.A. was held 12/30/1976. Two men and two women sat together in a room and shared their stories, finding comfort in the knowledge that they were not alone. From that day until today we have meetings all over the world and the original meeting still exists in Newton, MA.

In recognition of the 40th anniversary, NEI worked with FWS to put on an International Recovery Convention (IRC) this past summer. It was a wonderful event with over 40 recovery topic sessions and keynote speakers during a 3 day period. The theme of the convention was 40 Years: Evolving & Growing in Recovery and you can still hear some great speakers sharing their experience, strength, hope, and gratitude for these many years of S.L.A.A. recovery. Speakers represented 4 decades of recovery with varying levels of sobriety in celebration of this program.
